Laptop Care



- Carry in provided case at all times with both straps around your shoulders
- Do not walk around with PC open
- Do not attempt to repair or resolve technical issues.
- All laptops are the property of JCUSD 100, entrusted to the student to benefit their education



Laptop Care



- Do not leave unattended (charger and laptop).
- Avoid eating and drinking near the laptop.
- Avoid getting moisture in any of the openings and do not spray any type of liquid directly on the laptop.
- Be careful when using around young children and pets.

Suggested Internet Safety Guidelines



- Never give out personal information
- Never share passwords with anyone
- Never arrange a face-to-face meeting
- Do not open an e-mail if you do not know who sent it
- Do not click on banner adds or pop-up ads on websites
- Never use bad language or send threatening e-mails



Internet Filtering



- Server-based filtering software
 - Filtering software installed on JCUSD 100 web server.
 - Devices are filtered in the district and at home.

- Reminders concerning e-mail:
 - Threatening e-mail should never be sent
 - Attachments bring danger of viruses
 - **BE CAREFUL - Spam=Junk mail=Do not reply**

RUP



- Is located in the student handbooks online
- Just like a textbook or a locker, JCUSD 100 owns the laptop. Students are permitted to use it for educational purposes.

District administrators have the right and responsibility to check information on the laptops when there is reasonable suspicion of inappropriate use.



RUP



➤ **WARNING – IT IS A VIOLATION OF THE RUP TO:**

- Bypass the filter
- Use another student's username or password
- Share passwords
- Download or install personal software
- Tamper with hardware



Keeping your laptop Damage Free



- Do not leave a laptop unattended.
- Keep pets, food, drink, and babies away from the laptop.
- Laptop may not be used during school lunch – where food is on table.
- Do not leave your laptop in a vehicle.



You will be responsible for:



- If the machine is dropped (Lenovo voids the warranty)
- If the laptop/charger was “stolen” because it was left UNATTENDED
- If damage is due to not following the Required Use Policy (RUP)
 - Additional Information:
 - Each year students will receive same device
 - Each year student will receive same backpack
